Pesticides are the products Step Aside Pest Management, Inc. uses to control the target pests listed in your agreement. Pesticides makes better life for all by helping control disease carriers and wood destroying insects, thus protecting our health and property. When properly used, pesticides pose no problem to man or the environment. Your service technician is a state certified applicator whose knowledge is consistently being upgraded through regularly scheduled training sessions.

ODOR: In proper chemical application a *non-toxic odor* will be produced as a result of solvent evaporation. The odor will dissipate within a day or two. The odor contains no technical pesticide and is not hazardous.

Structural Pest Control Operators are licensed and regulated by the Structural Pest Control Board and apply pesticides which are registered and approved for use by the California Department of Food and Agricultural and the United States Environmental Protection Agency. Registration is granted when the state finds that based on existing scientific evidence there are no appreciable risks if proper use conditions are followed or that the risks are outweighed by the benefits. The degree of risk depends upon the degree of exposure so exposure should be minimized.

If within 24 hours following application your experience symptoms similar to common seasonal illness comparable to the flu, contact your physician or poison control and your pest control operator immediately.
